The Constitutional Court of the Slovak Republic does not have the competence to rule on the mitigation of injustices, and to order the surrender of movable or immovable objects which were transferred to the State or other legal entity during a certain decisive period. The competence to make decisions concerning such matters was granted to the State authorities under the so-called restitution laws adopted between 1990 and 1992.
